



DECLARATION OF A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY

Pursuant to the authority vested in the office of Mayor by the Illinois Municipal Code Section 5/11-1-6, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act Section 3305/11 and Municipal Code, Village of Cary, Illinois, Section 2.64.130, I, Mark R. Kownick, Mayor of the Village of Cary, do hereby declare that a Local Disaster Emergency exists as of this date, March 17th, 2020, and shall continue until such time as provided in Municipal Code, Village of Cary, Illinois, Section 2.64.130.

A local disaster emergency exists in the Village of Cary due to ongoing Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) concerns in the Village of Cary and McHenry County.

The nature of the emergency is to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local or interjurisdictional disaster emergency plans, to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance thereunder, and to bring this to as quick of a conclusion as possible.

During the existence of the Local Disaster Emergency, the Mayor shall execute such authority as provided under the Illinois Municipal Code, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act and Municipal Code, Village of Cary, Illinois, Section 2.64.130.

This Declaration of a Local Disaster Emergency shall be filed with the Deputy Village Clerk as soon as practicable.

I, Mark Kownick, Mayor, whose name is signed to this instrument, being first duly sworn, signed and executed the instrument as the Declaration of a Local Disaster Emergency, and that I signed willingly, and that I executed it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed.

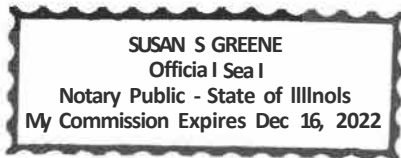
