On Thursday March 11, 2021 officers from the Cary Police Department responded to a residence in the Sterling Ridge subdivision located off Silver Lake Rd. for a delayed report of a criminal trespass and a vehicle and attached garage.

The resident called and reported finding their garage door and vehicle doors open, which caused them to check video footage from their home surveillance system.

The video showed that at approximately 12:55 a.m., three subjects exited a vehicle parked in the roadway in front of the residence, entered a presumably unlocked vehicle in the driveway, and used the garage door opener from the unlocked vehicle to gain access to the attached garage. One subject can be seen attempting to open the door of a vehicle parked in the driveway of the residence across the street. Once the garage door was open, two subjects entered the attached garage and the vehicle parked inside the garage.

In reviewing the video footage, officers saw one of the subjects who entered the attached garage carrying what appears to be a handgun. While this cannot be confirmed from the video, this is based on the manner in which the subject is carrying the item. The included images were taken from the surveillance video. The subjects are all wearing dark colored clothing and appear to be wearing gloves and face coverings:
