The Cary Police Department announces St. Patrick's Day 'Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over' enforcement results

Cary, Illinois – The Cary Police Department announced it made one DUI arrest and issued the following citations during the St. Patrick's Day enforcement period:

- One misdemeanor citation for Possession of Adult Use Cannabis in a Motor Vehicle – Driver
- Two Speeding citations
- One citation for a Graduated Driver's License – Passenger violation
- One citation for Operating an Uninsured Vehicle

"By keeping impaired drivers off the roads and ensuring that motorists and passengers are buckled up, we're able to help make the roads a safer place for everyone," said Deputy Chief Chris Winkelmann.

The Cary Police Department joined forces with highway safety partners and both state and local law enforcement in the St. Patrick's Day enforcement campaign.

The traffic safety effort was funded by federal highway safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation as part of the statewide "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" and "Click It or Ticket" campaigns.
