A MESSAGE FROM MAYOR MARK KOWNICK

Beginning today, all Illinois residents, when medically tolerable, are required to wear face coverings or masks in public places where social distancing cannot be maintained. Examples of public places include essential businesses, like grocery stores, as well as traveling on public transportation or picking up food from a drive-thru or curbside pick-up. The Village asks residents and businesses to comply with this order.

There have been additional modifications to the stay-at-home order regarding outside activities. Golf courses will be permitted to open with strict guidelines. Fishing and boating in groups of no more than two per watercraft will be permitted. Some state parks will reopen beginning today.
