On Wednesday January 20, 2021 at approximately 3:30 p.m. the Cary Police Department received a phone call from an unidentified female who stated she was with a male subject she feared would harm her, and she needed assistance from the police.

Through further investigation, officers were able to identify the female caller, and subsequently identify her general whereabouts. With assistance from the Crystal Lake Police Department, the female was located and the male subject in question was placed under arrested for violating an active order of protection.

Cary Police Department personnel learned the male offender, who had a prior relationship with the victim, held the victim against her will at her residence in Cary for approximately one day. During that time-period the male battered the woman on several occasions, and several times threatened to kill her. Pursuant to these findings, and in consultation with the McHenry County State's Attorney's Office, the male offender, 29-year old Jarrell A. Creekmore of Chicago, Illinois, was charged with the following:

Aggravated Domestic Battery/Strangulation (1 Count – Class 2 Felony)  
Aggravated Domestic Battery (2 Counts – Class 4 Felony)  
Unlawful Restraint (1 Count – Class 4 Felony)  
Violation of an Order of Protection (1 Count – Class 4 Felony)  
Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon (1 Count – Class A Misdemeanor)

Creekmore was transported to the McHenry County Adult Correctional Facility. This investigation is ongoing, and additional charges may be filed at a later date.
